# Cannubi, Barolo

The first vineyard to be written on an Italian wine label



If there were a classification in Piedmont similar to the one in Burgundy, the Cannubi vineyard would be considered one of the very few Grand Cru that exist in Barolo. Furthermore, and with little debate, Cannubi would easily be among the most famous Crus in all of Italy. The vineyard itself, as a parcel of recognized land, dates back to the 1700s. Wine has been made from this soil for generations. The oldest surviving bottle in the world is preserved in Bra by the words "Cannubi 1752". Cannubi is the first vineyard site to be written on an Italian wine label. To have its name placed on a label when that was not at all a common way of doing things, speaks volumes about just how important and relevant Cannubi has been considered throughout history. Cannubi predates Barolo. The official vineyard district identified as Cannubi



is a very long, gently sloping hill encircled by two roads. Vineyards are southeast and east-facing and progressively steeper hills from a low point of about 220 meters above sea level to 320 meters in altitude. Nowadays, the entire hillside can be called Cannubi, but historically there were many different parts to the hill, each with its own name. One very interesting and meritorious fact about the extended Cannubi vineyard district is that it has been turned into an organically farmed vineyard area almost entirely. The credit for the initiative must go to Chiara Boschis who was the person who had the idea and then the main proponent of such a move; over the years, she worked hard and interacted closely with her Cannubi colleagues to get them to jump on board. 11 families own portions of the vineyard and producers, seeking prestige and the increased revenue the name provides, wish to have the coveted word "Cannubi" on their wine labels.

# Roagna

All creatures living in the vineyards are allowed to play a unique role in the biodiversity of the terroir



Today the property is run by Luca Roagna, the fifth generation of the family. Luca was born in 1980, and succeeded to winemaking for the property soon after his graduation from oenological school in

2001. The heart of the Roagna estate is its six and a half hectares of vineyards in the commune of Barbaresco, most of these lying in the fine cru of Pajè. From the Pajè vineyard the Roagna family now makes three distinct cuvées, a Barbaresco “normale” labeled as Barbaresco “Pajè,” a Barbaresco Paje Vecchie Vite (old vines) and “Crichèt Pajè” – made from the crest of the Paje cru. In 1989 the family’s long-held aspirations of owning top level crus in Barolo comparable to their Pajè holdings

in Barbaresco came true, when they purchased a parcel historically known as La Rocche e La Pira, in the fabled village of Castiglione Falletto.

Roagna practices organic viticulture and Luca intends to establish full biodiversity in its soil and to follow permaculture principles. Grasses and cover crops that grow between the vines aren’t mowed or ploughed, providing a natural compost for the vines. Luca demonstrates the utmost respect for his land, with old vines, massale selection, and biodiversity at the core of his approach. Roagna’s approach to viticulture is deeply personal and draws inspiration from many sources, from Rudolph Steiner to Masanobu Fukuoka.

# Teroldego

an ancient history of Teroldego.



Teroldego grape is only grown in the Trentino Region of northern Italy.

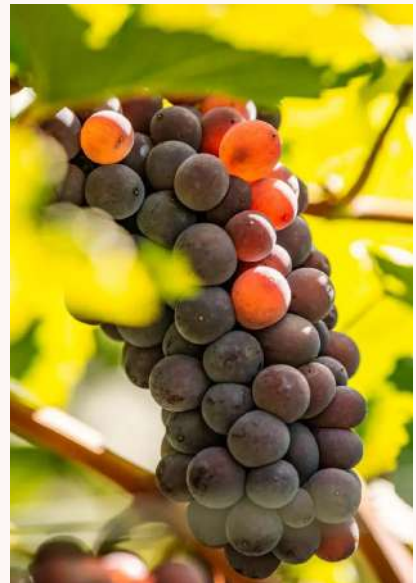
In Trentino, there's the Campo Rotaliano plain covering less than four square kilometers, including parts of Mezzolombardo, Mezzacorona, and Grumo San Michele all'Adige. Teroldego grapes from this area, known for their distinct color and elongated bunches, are used by only 29 nearby wineries to make the esteemed D.O.C. wine. Teroldego Rotaliano was among the first Italian wines to receive the DOC designation in 1971. The

Rotaliano plain, near the confluence of the River Noce and River Adige, has a unique microclimate and soil perfect for Teroldego grapes. It enjoys southern sun exposure and protection from Brenta Dolomites to the north and east. The soil, deposited by the Noce, is well-drained with fertile topsoil over layers of pebbles, gravel, and sand, containing various minerals like limestone, shale, sandstone, and granite.

Teroldego is an old variety, first mentioned in 1383 in a deed of sale.

Teroldego boasts a rich anthocyanin content, resulting in a deep, luscious purple hue. Its flavor profile is characterized by fruity notes reminiscent of raspberry and wild berries, accompanied by hints of spice, licorice, quinine, and tar. The wine offers a medium tannic structure and well-balanced acidity.

Elisabetta Foradori is a queen of Teroldego grapes, she makes one of the finest examples of Teroldego on the planet.

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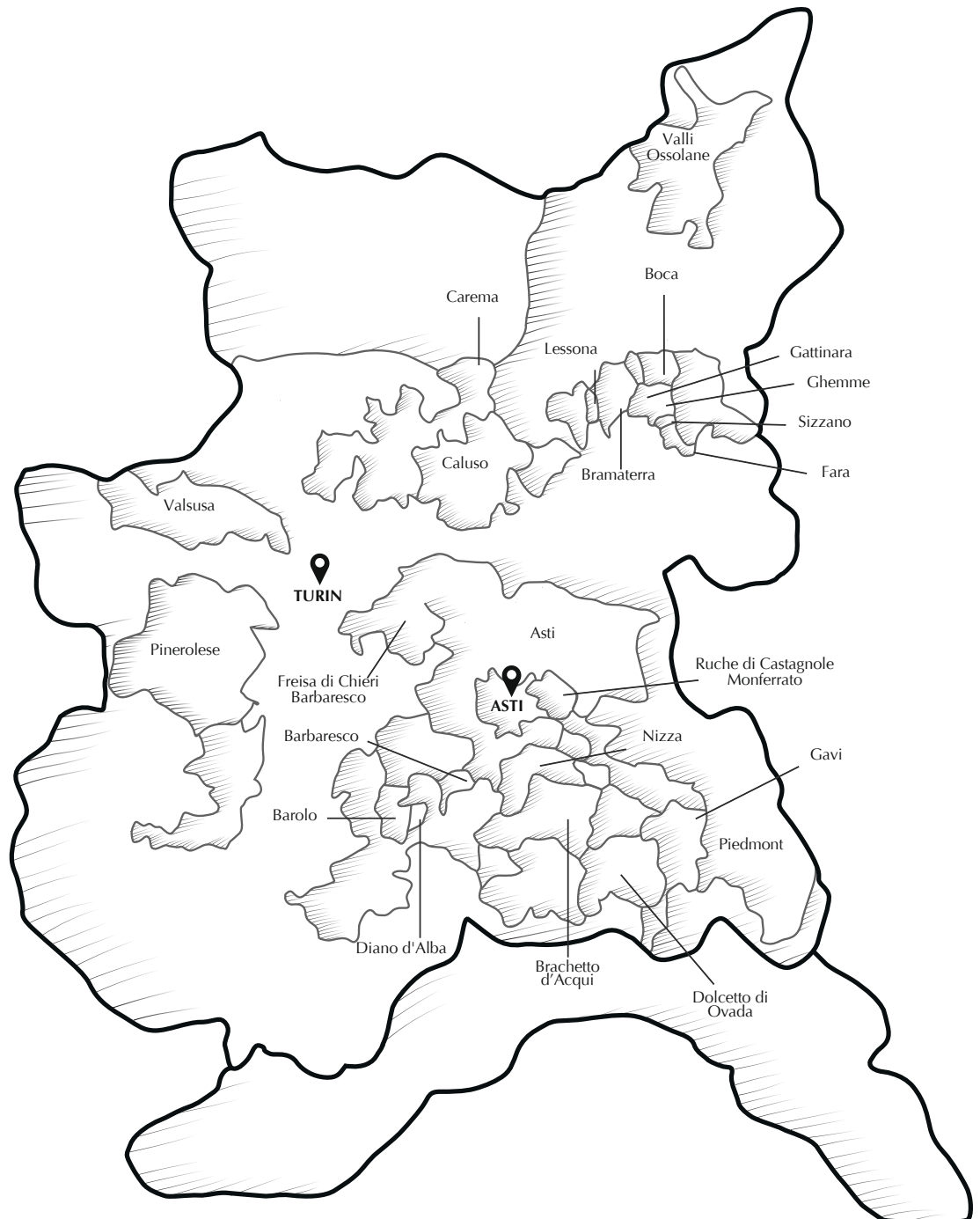
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# Piedmont

## ITALY

Piemonte (Piedmont) occupies most of northwestern Italy, bordering Switzerland in the north and France in the west and almost reaching the Mediterranean coast. In the wine world, Piemonte is best known for the twin titans of Barolo and Barbaresco, along with other popular red wines made from Barbera and Dolcetto, the white Gavi, and sparkling Asti. It has more DOCGs (18) than any other region and is tied with Toscana for most DOCs (41), but no IGP.

Wine production more leaning 60-40 toward red wines and with a stunning 94% at the DOP level. The region's grape varieties are Nebbiolo, Barbera, Moscato, Dolcetto, Timorasso, Freisa, Ruche, Grignolio, Arneis. Piedmont is a region of gastronomic excellence, Alba truffles are one of the world's most prized culinary delicacies. Piedmont cuisine are warm and hearty dishes.

Angelo Gaja has now left the day-to-day business to his daughters Gaia and Rossana, and his son Giovanni at the age of 70, the fifth generation of the family.

However, Gaja attaches great importance to the fact that he is not yet retired. Today Gaja has 100 hectares of vineyards divided into 32 separate plots in Piedmont and 147 hectares in Montalcino and Bolgheri. The philosophy of Gaja is a single vineyard an independent organism, a universe where different forms of life coexist. The purpose is to understand, protect and grow the life enclosed in every vineyard for the exclusive production of Gaja wines.

His five single-vineyard Nebbiolo wines: Sori San Lorenzo, Sori Tildin and Costa Russi from the Barbaresco zone and Sperss and Conteisa from the Barolo zone are one of the great appellations of the world.

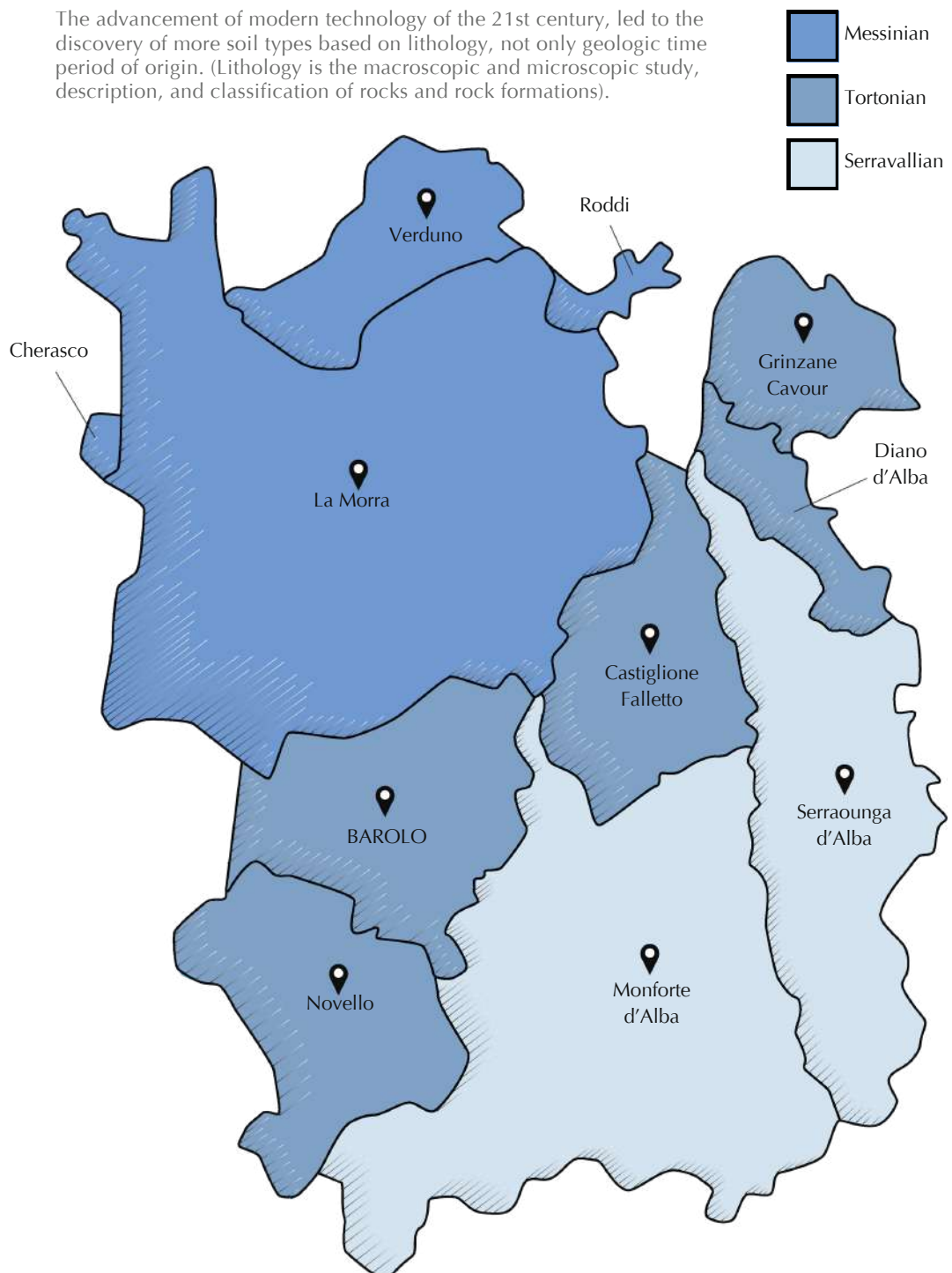
# Barolo

## Italy

The Barolo denomination extends over the territories of 11 producing communes: it is from the territories of these 11 towns, and only these, that a wine called Barolo can be made. In alphabetical order, these communes are: Barolo, Castiglione Falletto, Cherasco, Diano d'Alba, Grinzane Cavour, La Morra, Monforte d'Alba, Novello, Roddi, Serralunga d'Alba and Verduno.

Barolo geology is an amazingly fascinating subject but one that is also extremely complicated. The landscape was formed during the last 3 stages of the Miocene epoch. From oldest to youngest, these are: the Serravalian, the Tortonian and the Messinian. The south-eastern part (the southern part of Serralunga d'Alba) is the oldest, dating from the **Serravalian age (13 to 11 million years ago)**; the central part is from the more recent **Tortonian age (11 to 7 million years ago)**; the north-western part of the region is the youngest, from the **Messinian age (7 to 5 million years ago)**. Barolo's youngest soil - Messinian origin, characterized by relatively light in texture, as are the wines made from them. These are Barolos of great perfume and vibrant lift, but don't have the structure of those born off Serravalian soils, or even Tortonian soils. Barolos made from grapes grown on Messinian soils are most approachable early in life, while Serravalian soils will give life to the most tannic, slowly developing Barolos of all, with Tortonian soil Barolos falling in between these two extremes.

The advancement of modern technology of the 21st century, led to the discovery of more soil types based on lithology, not only geologic time period of origin. (Lithology is the macroscopic and microscopic study, description, and classification of rocks and rock formations).

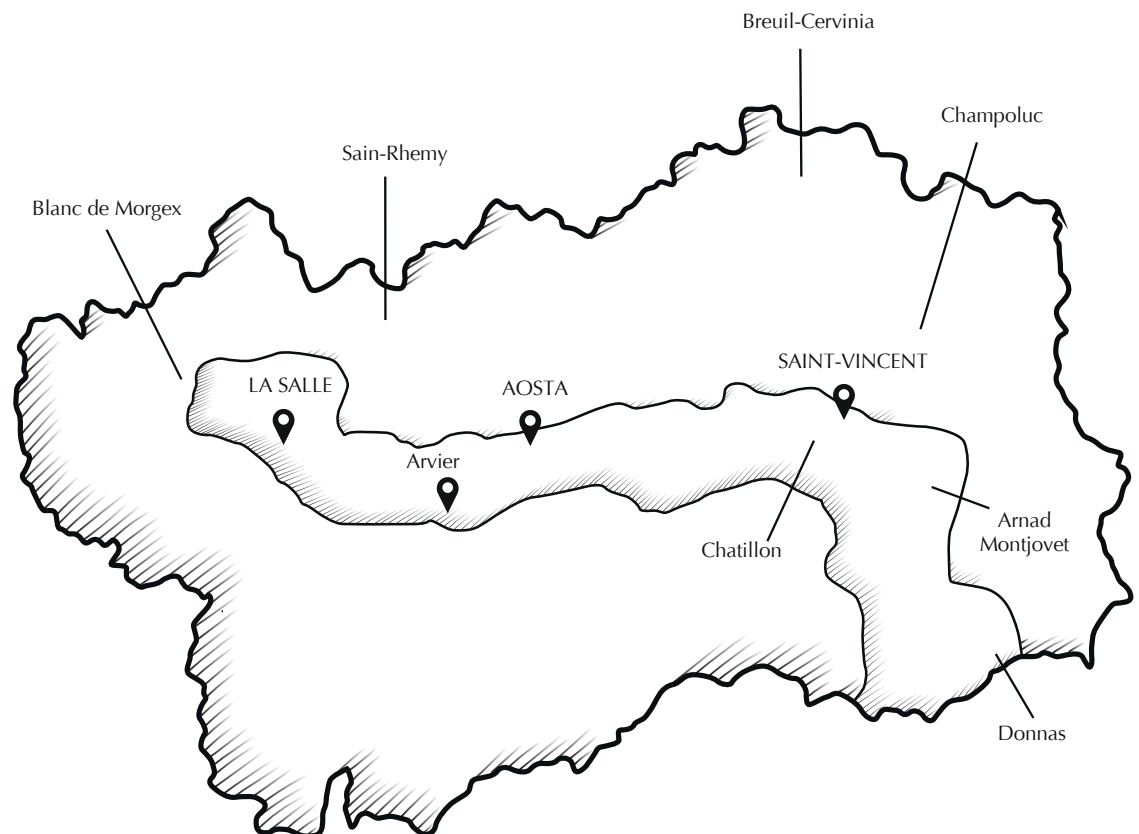
# Valle d'Aosta

ITALY

Valle d'Aosta (the Aosta Valley) is located in extreme northwestern Italy, bordering both France and Francophone Switzerland. The climate is continental, cold winters and warm summers. Because of its proximity to France, Valle d'Aosta—or Vallée d'Aoste—often uses French terms in place of Italian ones.

Its capital and largest town is Aosta. As Italy's smallest and least populous region, most of it too mountainous for agriculture, Valle d'Aosta not surprisingly has by far the smallest wine production of any Italian region. Its production is almost 60% red. The region's grape varieties are Petit Rouge, Nebbiolo, Pinot Nero, Prié Blanc, Fumin and Petite Arvine.

It has just one DOC - Valle d'Aosta DOC, with no DOCGs or IGPs. Local dishes include warming soups, polenta, black bread, gnocchi, rice and potatoes, risotto, cheeses and salami. Fontina is probably the most famous cheese of the region, a fat cheese, partially cooked, made from cow's milk from a single milking. The cheese is also used for fondue or as a sauce for the typical Aosta Valley polenta.

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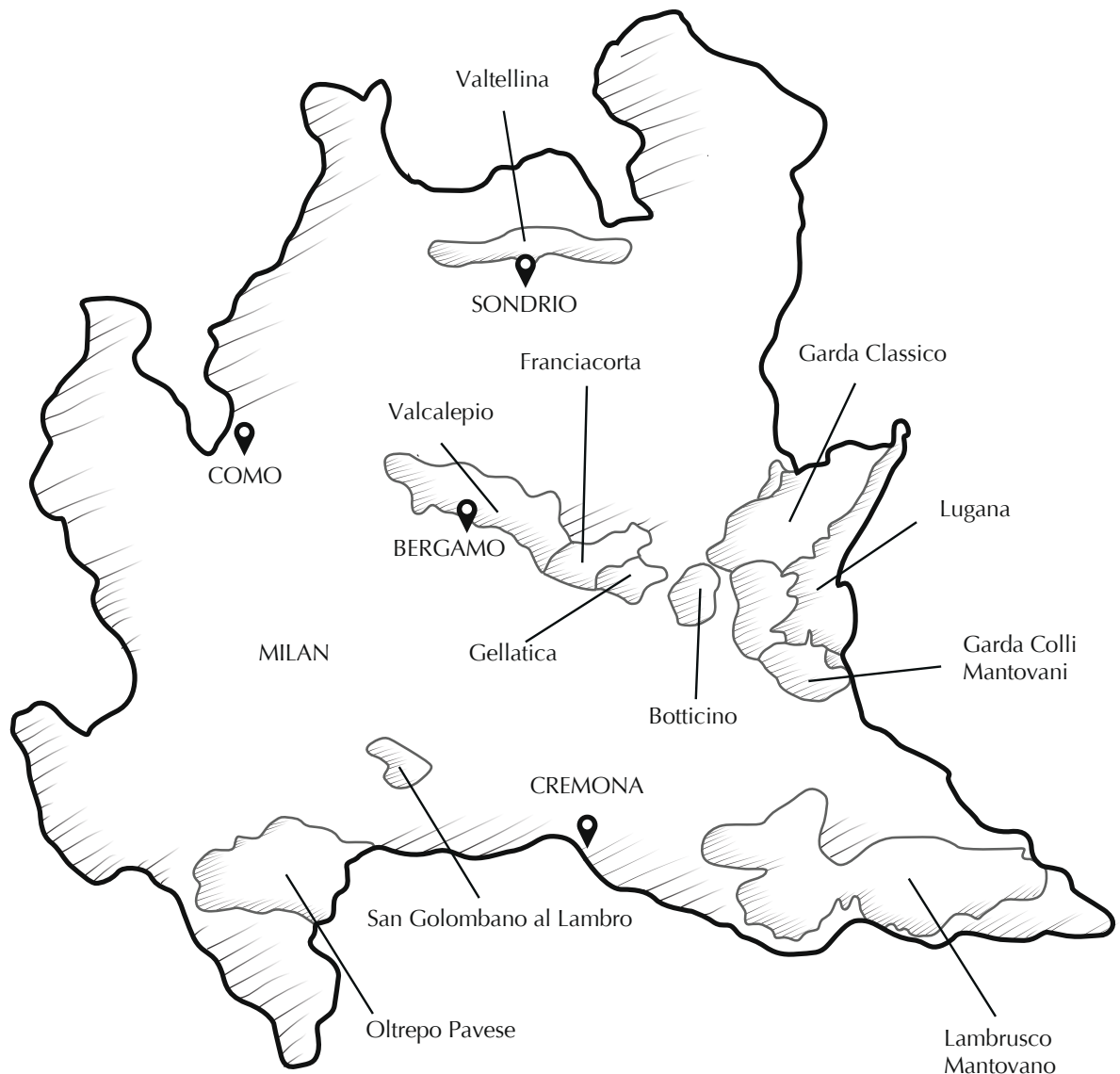
# Lombardy

## ITALY

Lombardia (Lombardy) is located centrally in Italy's northern tier, stretching south from the Swiss border to the top of the peninsula. Its capital and largest city is Milan (Milano), the country's second most populous city and one of the wealthiest. Tourists know Lombardia for Milan itself—Malpensa airport, La Scala, the duomo—as well as stunning Lake Como.

In the wine world, Lombardia is probably best known for the classic-method sparkling wines of Franciacorta. The region has 5 DOCGs, 21 DOCs, and 15 IGP. The region's grape varieties are Nebbiolo, locally known as Chiavennasca, Croatina, Pinot Nero, Chardonnay and Barbera. Harvesting here is definitely a feat for the winemakers and those picking grapes as the slopes are very steeply terraced so everything is hand harvested.

It has been deemed a UNESCO World Heritage Site as well for its antique vineyard structures. The region's cuisine is equally rich, with expensive spices, prime cuts of meat and aged cheeses bringing flair to risotto and polenta-based dishes.

# Trentino-Alto Adige

## ITALY

Trentino-Alto Adige is the northernmost Italian region, comprising two areas with very different personalities: the Germanic Alto Adige or Südtirol, which borders and once belonged to Austria, and right below it the more Italian but still very Alpine Trentino. The region's capital and largest city is Trento, followed closely by the Südtirol provincial capital, Bozen (Bolzano). The breathtaking valley of the Adige River is renowned in the wine world for varietally labeled cool-climate wines of a universally high quality.



Though it has no DOCGs, the region's 8 DOCs account for 93% of its wine production; most of the remainder is labeled with one of the four IGPs. Trentino-Alto Adige produce more than 70% of it white. The region's grape varieties are Pinot Bianco, Pinot Grigio, Schiava, Lagrein, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay.

A tradition closely linked to Austrian and German cuisine, which puts grains and cured meats as its trademarks, and which makes Trentino a unique place: the cuisine here is a mix of unmistakable flavours and aromas, a succession of spicy and smoked scents which enrich many of the local specialities.

Ferrari Trento was named 3 times "Sparkling Wine Producer of the Year" by The Champagne and Sparkling Wine World Championships, the most important competition in the world dedicated only to bubbles. Ferrari is the toast of Italy par excellence and accompanies the most important moments in culture, sport and entertainment. Although the estate passed to the Lunelli family in 1952, the Ferrari Trento wines are world-renowned for their expressive nature, flavour, fragrance and complexity, that stand testament to the power and potential of Italian Metodo Classico wines.

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# Veneto

## ITALY

Veneto is located in northeastern Italy, at the top of the Adriatic Sea. Its capital and largest city is Venice (Venezia), although Verona is nearly as large. Tourists come to Veneto primarily to visit the fabled city of Venice and Romeo and Juliet's balcony in Verona, but the region has a wealth of other gems as well, including Padua (Padova), Vicenza, the Dolomite Alps, and Lake Garda.



In the wine world, Veneto is best known for red Valpolicella (including Amarone), white Soave, and sparkling Prosecco. It has the second most DOCGs (14), along with 29 DOCs and 10 IGP. More than 80% of Veneto's production is white wine—the most of any Italian region, thanks mainly to Prosecco and Delle Venezie—with 78% at the DOP level.

The region's grape varieties are Glera, Garganega, Corvina and Pinot Grigio. Local delicacies are sardine saor, consisting of marinated sardines; bigoli in salsa, composed of traditional bigoli pasta and a sauce made from anchovies; or risi e bisi, a popular risotto made with rice and green peas.

Bussola considers himself a modern-traditionalist, somewhere between an innovative Dal Forno and a traditional Quintarelli. His wines, labelled TB, which took off from 1995, show characteristics of ripe fruit and velvety textures. His success, and increase in demand, have encouraged him to invest a property and winery in the area of Negrar. Planted with Corvina, Corvinone and the almost extinct variety Dindorella. Bussola Valpolicella is defined by its very diverse microclimate and terroir, which can change completely within a few metres. Its poor mineral soils favour rich, complex wines.

When Veneto legend Giuseppe Quintarelli was asked years ago to name the region's next superstar, he didn't hesitate: Tommaso Bussola. Among the countless accolades he received, Gambero Rosso gave him the first of many Tre Bicchieri for his majestic Recioto TB.

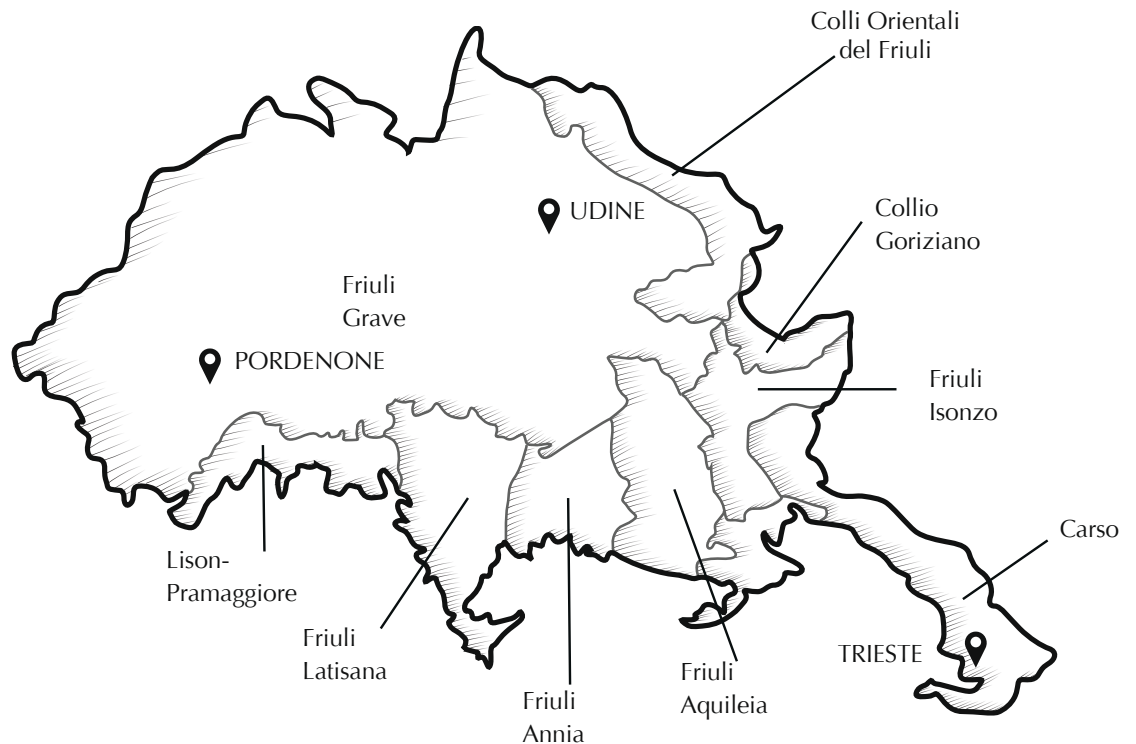
## ITALY

Friuli-Venezia Giulia lies in extreme northeastern Italy, with Slovenia bordering it on the east and Austria on the north. Its capital and largest city is Trieste, which is in the small Venezia Giulia portion in the southeast. In the wine world, Friuli-Venezia Giulia is best known for white wines made from such varieties as Pinot Grigio and Friulano, although it is also a source of Prosecco. It has 4 DOCGs, 12 DOCs, and 3 IGPs. Friuli-Venezia Giulia produce 76% of it white—the highest proportion of white wine of any region except neighboring Veneto.



The region's grape varieties are Pinot Grigio, Glera, Friulano, Pignolo, Refosco, Traminer, Schioppettino. The cuisine of Friuli Venezia Giulia is influenced by Slavic, central European and Venetian cooking traditions.

Among the typical dishes: polenta, cooked in several ways and with different dressing and gubana, a wrap dough stuffed with dried fruit. Prosciutto San Daniele is known and exported all over the world, while Sauris smoked ham is a specialty known by few.

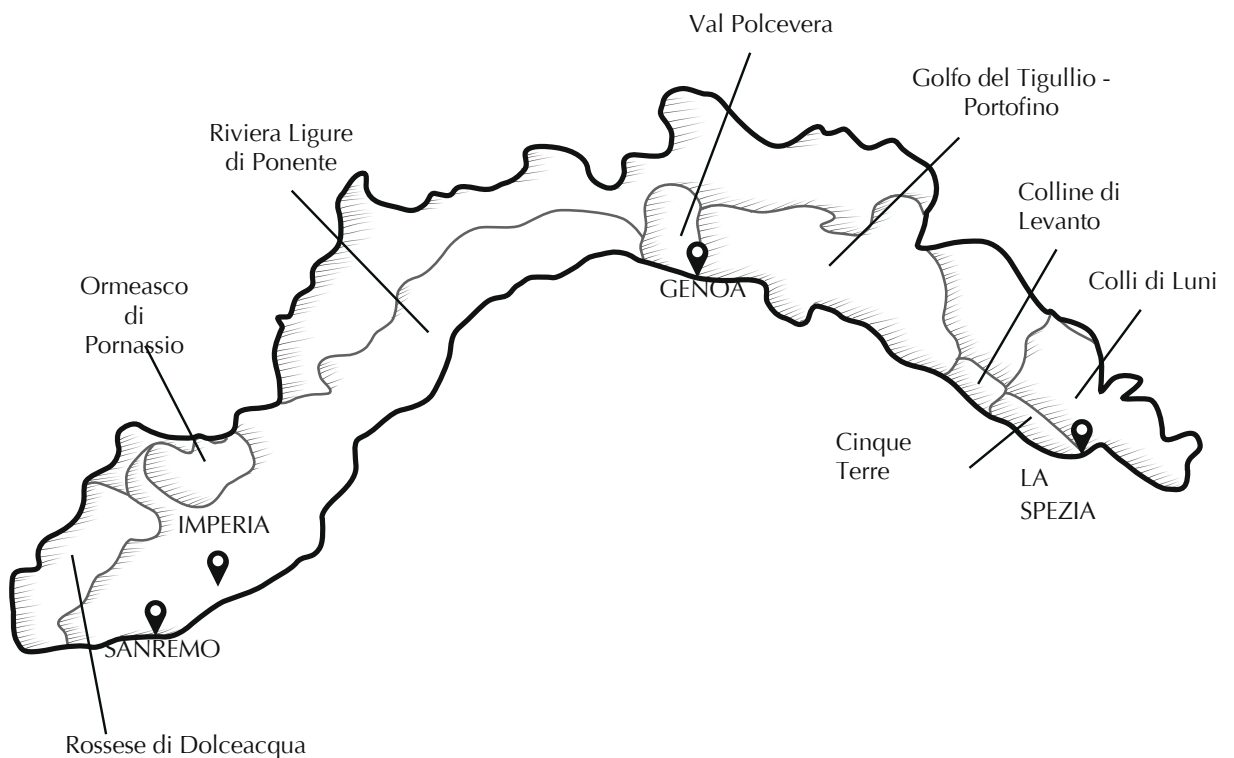
# Liguria

## ITALY

Liguria is a tiny arch stretching from the French border to the Northern part of Tuscany. It lays beneath Piemonte and Emilia Romagna, and is crossed by mountains (the Alps in the Western most part and the Appennins through to the boundary with Tuscany). Liguria is entirely facing the Ligurian Sea.

Its capital and largest city is Genoa (Genova). Tourists know Liguria as the Italian Riviera, famous for its beaches and the idyllic towns of Portofino and the Cinque Terre. In the wine world, Liguria is not well known outside the Riviera because its production is quite small, second least of the Italian regions. It has no DOCGs, 8 DOCs, and eight IGPs. Liguria wines over 70% of it white.

The region's grape varieties are Vermentino, locally known as Pigato, Rossese and Cilieggiolo. The region of Liguria has a Mediterranean climate but it is not so uniform: this is due to the fact that Liguria's morphology in great measure shows highlands opening on a very warm sea compared to its high latitude. Despite the limited production, wines from Liguria, especially the white ones, are renown for their elegance and freshness.

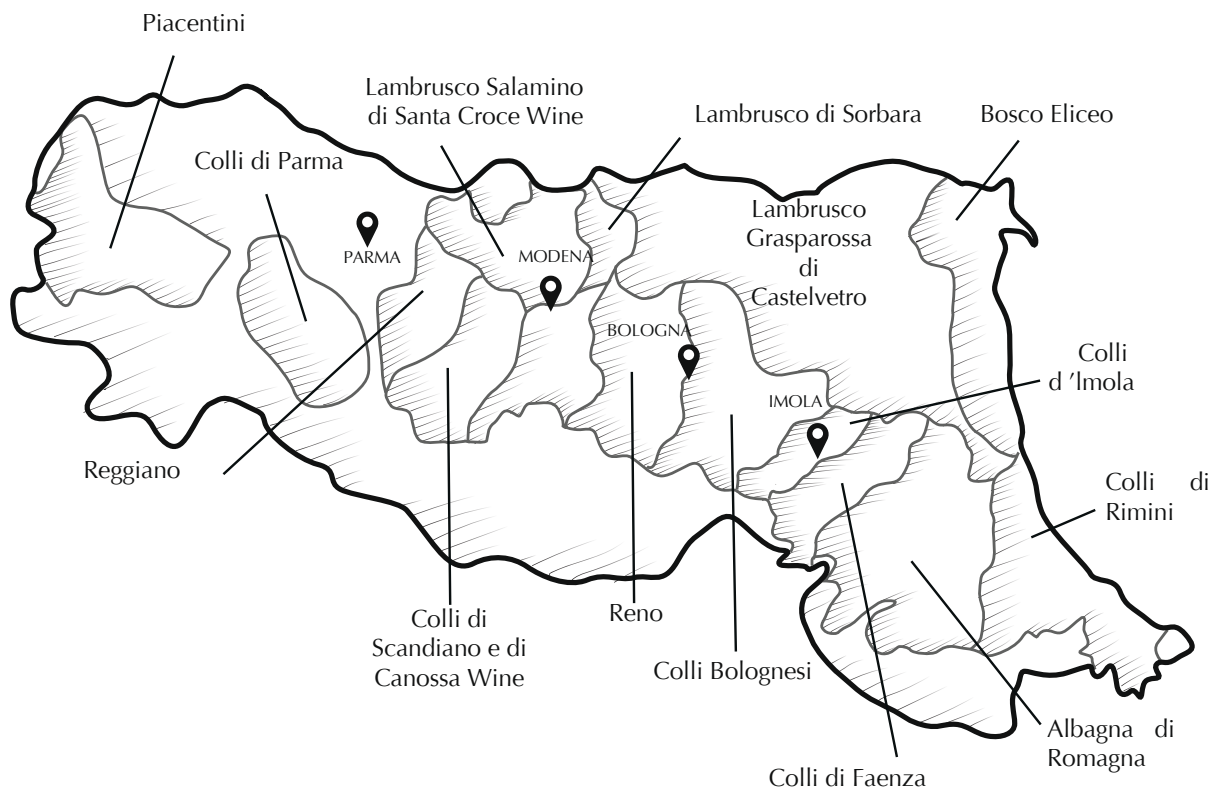

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# Emilia-Romagna

## ITALY

Emilia-Romagna runs across the top of the Italian peninsula, south of the Po River, from the Adriatic Sea almost to the west coast. Its capital and largest city is Bologna. Emilia to the west, and Romagna on the coast to the east. Tourists know Emilia-Romagna as a food mecca, including the cities of Bologna, Modena, Reggiano, and Parma.

In the wine world, Emilia-Romagna is best known for the once wildly popular fizzy red wines made from Lambrusco. It has 2 DOCGs, 19 DOCs. The region's grape varieties are Trebbiano, Lambrusco, and Sangiovese. The vineyards benefit from the regions humid, subtropical climate that has virtually no dry season. Bologna and the wider Emilia-Romagna region are responsible for having given us balsamic vinegar, mortadella, parmesan cheese and parma ham.

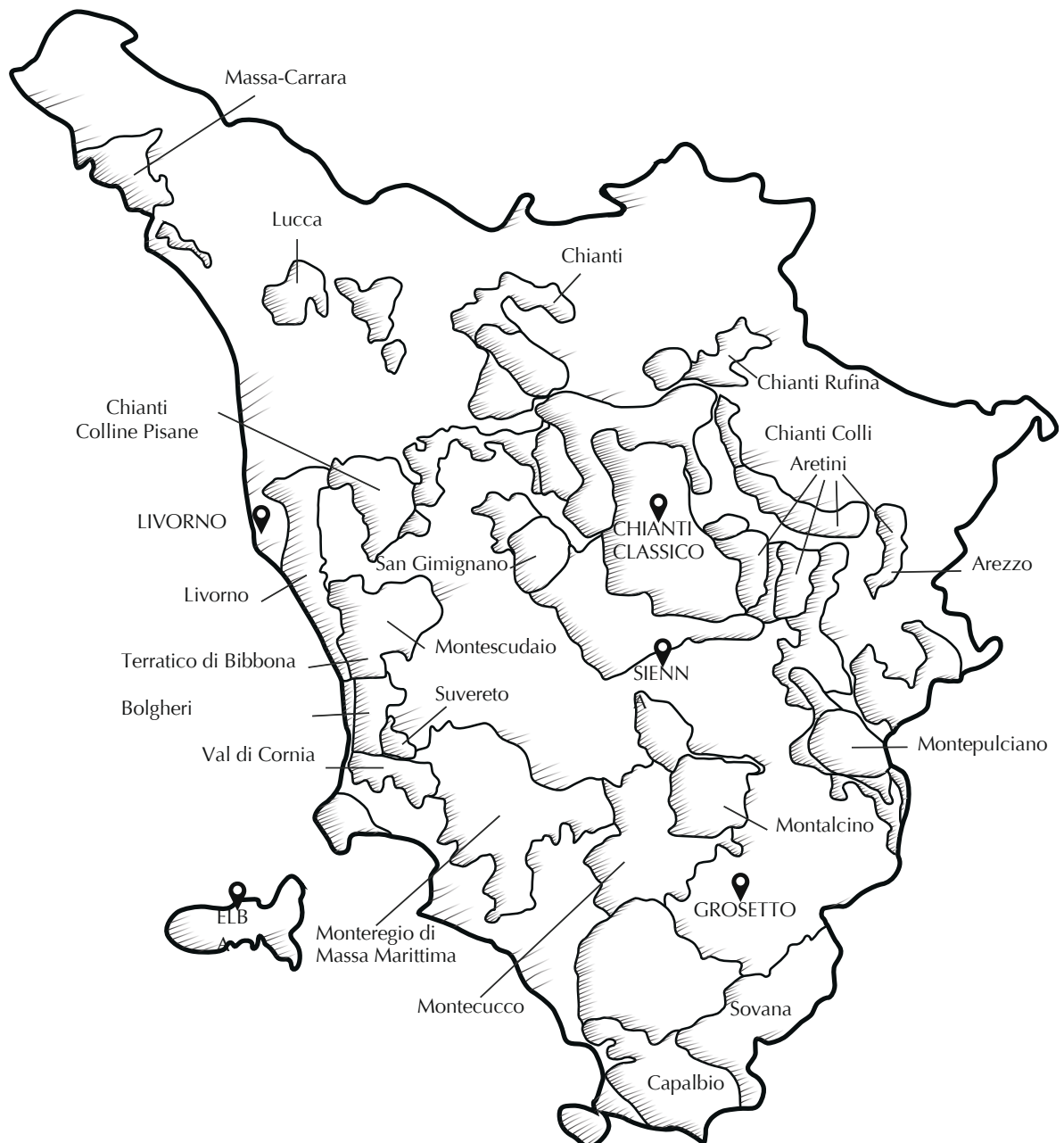
## ITALY

Toscana (Tuscany) is located at the top of the Italian peninsula on the west coast. Toscana is the quintessential Italy, and tourists flock here in droves for the majestic city of Florence (Firenze), the hill towns, the rustic yet regal villas in the countryside, and great food. In the wine world, Toscana is best known for red wines made from Sangiovese, especially Brunello di Montalcino and Chianti.



There is another category of wines IGT Toscana represents the second biggest 'appellation' within the region. It has 11 DOCGs and, in a tie with Piemonte, the most DOCs of any Italian region (41), plus 6 IGP. The region's dominant grape variety is Sangiovese, and it has the highest proportion of red wine of any region —87%.

Almost two thirds of Toscana's wine is at the DOP level. SuperTuscans, continue to lead fine wines. The term SuperTuscan was first coined in the mid-1980s by the English journalist and Master of Wine Nicolas Belfrage and was then adopted by the English and American press.

### TENUTA SAN GUIDO SASSICAIA

Tenuta San Guido Sassicaia is a legend, thanks to such legendary vintages as 1985, which Robert Parker, the most influential wine critic of all time, as he told WineNews, has defined, “the wine that I have absolutely liked the most in my 37-year career”.

Even more recent vintages have been outstanding, such as 2015, number 1 on the “Top 100” by “Wine Spectator”, one of the most awaited and followed rankings in the world; or the 2016 vintage, judged 100/100 points by “The Wine Advocate”, founded by Robert Parker, and whose correspondent in Italy is Monica Lerner.

## MONTEVERTINE

### MONTEVERTINE

Montevervine is situated in the heart of the Chianti district about halfway between Florence and Siena, specifically 3 kilometers or so south of Radda in Chianti. Documents attest to the fact that the hilltop hamlet of Montevervine was first inhabited in the 11th century as a rural defensive fortress. There are traces of the original construction on the site today. Sergio Manetti acquired Montevervine in 1967 as a vacation home for his family. Once there, Signor Manetti planted two hectares of vineyards and built a small cantina with the idea of producing some wine for family and friends. The first vintage produced and bottled under the supervision of Signor Manetti was 1971 and was received with great praise for its quality. Shortly thereafter, Signor Manetti abandoned his principal activity to devote himself to producing wine at his magnificent estate.

Having recognized the importance of the Sangiovese grape, Signor Manetti crafted his wines with an almost exclusive reliance on that grape variety. By 1981, due to Signor Manetti's refusal to incorporate Trebbiano into the Montevervine blend, Montevervine left the Chianti Classico consortium, thereby forgoing the Chianti Classico denomination. In time the consortium recognized the wisdom of Manetti's stance but Montevervine remains outside the consortium, simply labeling its wines "Rosso di Toscana". Because of these circumstances, Montevervine is frequently, but erroneously, included in the category of "super-Tuscan" wine. In fact, Montevervine's policy of strict reliance on Sangiovese with a small complement of Colorino and Canaiolo is in direct contradiction to the approach of the "super-Tuscan" group of wines which purposely include non-local grape varieties like Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Merlot in their blends. Despite the formal lack of the appellation, Montevervine is one of the rare examples of a true Chianti Classico.

Recent years have seen a generational shift at the Montevervine estate with the passing of Sergio Manetti, Giulio Gambelli (the estate's oenologue for many years, and a fierce proponent of the Sangiovese grape), and most recently Bruno Bini (the cellarmaster). Montevervine is now in the hands of Martino Manetti, son of Sergio, and Paolo Salvi, Gambelli's protégée, both of whom remain dedicated to the style and philosophy of their forebears. We are confident that this seamless transition means that Montevervine's tradition of excellence will be carried into the future.

The estate sits at an elevation of 425 meters. There are 18 hectares of vineyards at Montevervine, 90% of which are planted to the Sangiovese grape with the remaining vineyards dedicated to Colorino and Canaiolo. The vineyards are divided into nine separate parcels with the oldest vines planted in the Pergole Torte vineyard in 1968. After a manual harvest, the wines are fermented in large (150hl) cement cuves for at least 25 days. The wine is pumped over and the cap submerged daily to create optimum conditions for a long and slow extraction. The malolactic fermentation also occurs in large volume cement cuves before it is racked into Slavonian oak barrels that range in size from 5 ½ to 18 hectoliters capacity. The Pergole Torte is ultimately racked into smaller French (Alliers) oak barrels for final six months of its élevage.

All movement of the wine is by gravity and the wine is never pumped, in accordance with the traditional methods of the region. The wines are bottled without filtration and then held in bottle for at least six months prior to release.

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# Marche

## ITALY

Le Marche is located on the Adriatic coast toward the top of the Italian peninsula. Its capital and largest city is Ancona. In the wine world, Marche is best known for white wines made from Verdicchio and perhaps for Montepulciano-based red wines like Rosso Cònero and Rosso Piceno. It has 5 DOCGs, 15 DOCs and 1 IGP. The region plays host to the vineyards of two main types of Verdicchio: Castelli di Jesi DOC and di Matelica DOC.



Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi is the better-known and more prestigious appellation and, due to the close proximity of the sea, it can offer a range of styles. Due to the influences of the Apennines, the Adriatic and the region's rivers (the Metauro, Potenza, Tronto and Nera), there are various climates at work in Marche. In Marche region we can find truffles all year-round: each season has its type of truffle and a unique gastronomic experience. Le Marche is known for its olives and high-quality olive oil, especially the olio extravergine di Cartoceto DOP with slightly bitter notes and spicy fruitiness.

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# Umbria

## ITALY

Umbria is located in the center of Italy, in the Apennines north of Rome and east of Toscana. It is known as the 'green heart' of Italy and is the only Italian region without a coastal border, being enclosed by the Marche, Tuscany and Lazio. Its capital and largest city is Perugia. Umbria is a landscape of beautiful lakes and medieval hilltop villages which seem to rise from the mist: notably Assisi, Spoleto, Todi and Montefalco.



In the wine world, Umbria is best known for white wines from one of those hill towns, Orvieto, and red wines from another, Montefalco. The region has 2 DOCGs, 13 DOCs. Grape varieties are Sagrantino, Trebbiano, and Sangiovese. Mediterranean climate, the summers are hot and dry, and the temperature is mild in the winter. Known for its medieval towns and lush landscapes of olive groves, dense forests and hills, Umbria is also one of the top culinary regions in Italy, famous for truffles, chocolate and wine.

# Lazio

## ITALY

Lazio (Latium) is located halfway down the western side of the Italian peninsula, between the Apennines and the Tyrrhenian Sea. Its capital and largest city is the national capital, Rome. With its millennia of history as one of the world's most important cities, Rome is still the heart of Italy, and visitors to Lazio spend most of their time seeing the myriad monuments of the city.



In the wine world, Lazio is best known for white wines such as Colli Albani, Est! Est!! Est!!!, and Frascati made in the local hills to supply Roman tables. It has 3 DOCGs, 26 DOCs, and 6 IGP. Nearly three quarters of the output was white and about half at the DOP level. The region's grape varieties are Malvasia, Trebbiano and Cesanese.

Lazio has a Mediterranean climate that is influenced by mountains, wind, rivers, and sea. Rich soil in Lazio produces excellent artichokes. Carbonara, Cacio e Pepe, Trippa alla Romana (Roman Tripe), Carciofi alla Giudia (Jewish-style Artichokes), Roman-style pizza.

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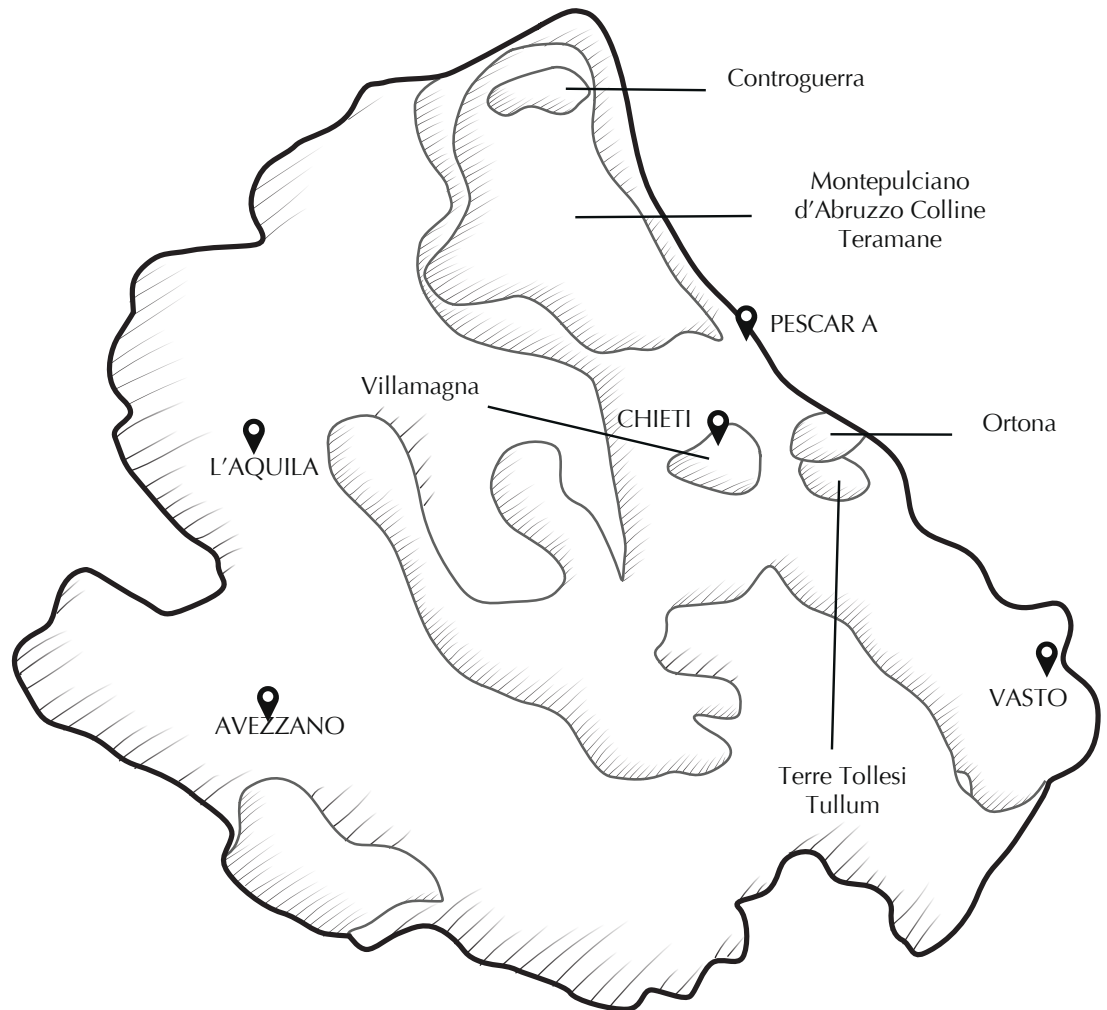
# Abruzzo

## ITALY

Abruzzo is located halfway down the Italian peninsula, across the Apennine range east of Rome. Its capital is L'Aquila and its largest city is Pescara. In the wine world, Abruzzo is best known as the home of the Montepulciano grape. It has 2 DOCGs, 7 DOCs. (Colline Teramane Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOCG, Terre Tollesi / Tullum DOCG) and 8 IGP. About 58% of production is red and less than 30% is at the DOP level.

Its grape varieties are Montepulciano, Trebbiano, Pecorino and Passerina. The region is blessed with a favourable climate; the vines grow in a sort of amphitheatre, protected by the high mountains and warmed by the sea breezes.

In the last few years, Abruzzo has seen a huge increase in small and independent producers going back to their roots, rediscovering traditional grapes and terroirs. Lamb with cheese and eggs is a typical dish of the Abruzzo. The lamb morsels are flavored with a pecorino and egg cream, strictly local.

# Molise

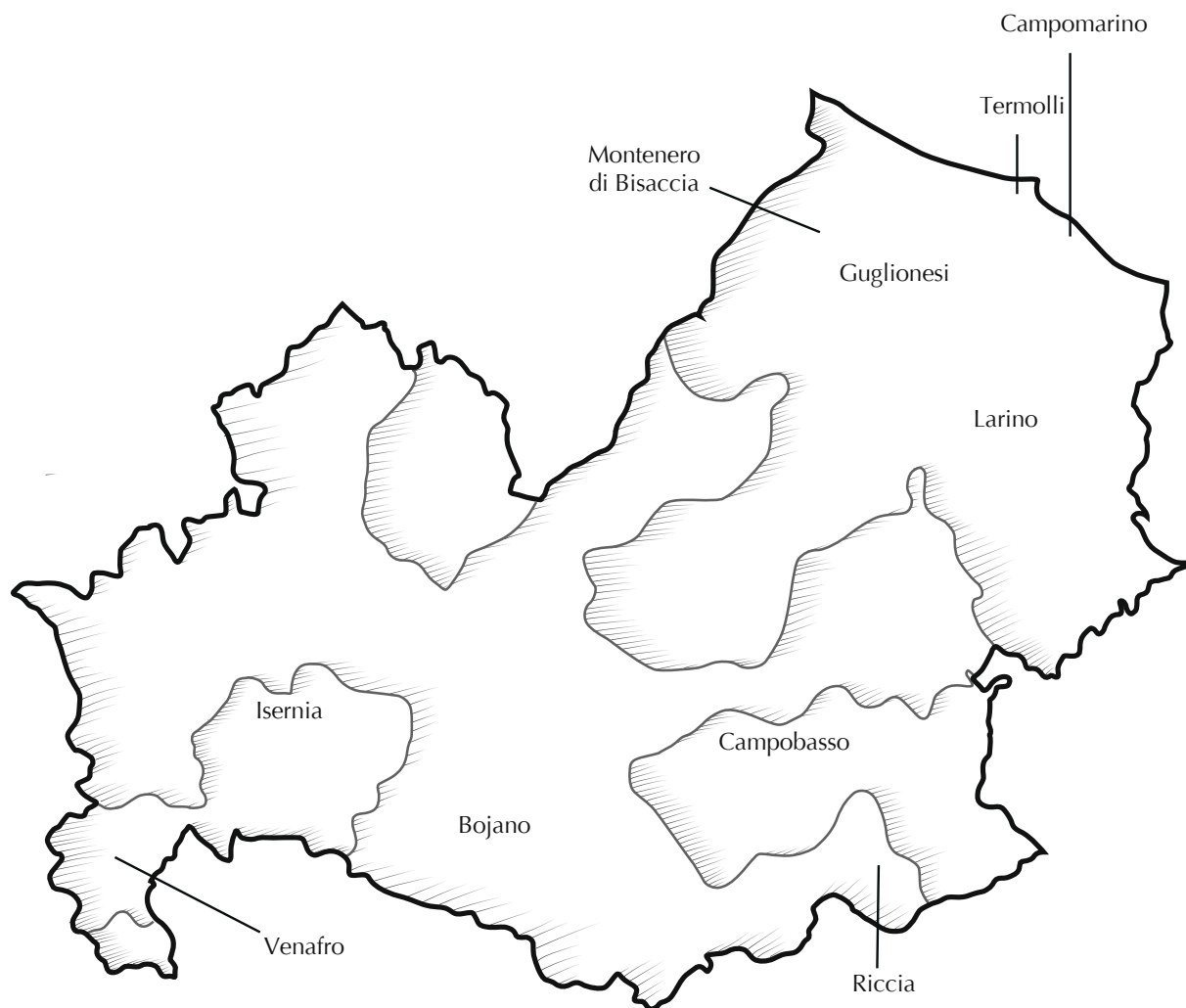
## ITALY

Molise is Italy's second smallest region (after Valle d'Aosta) by both area and population. It lies on the Adriatic coast, squeezed between Abruzzo and Puglia. Its capital and largest city is Campobasso. Molise is not the typical Italian tourist spot, even though it is rich in history, with breathtaking mountains and hills and more than 200 castles. The region is one of Italy's best-kept secrets – it was never promoted as much as other wine regions such as Tuscany or Campania.



It has no DOCGs, 4 DOCs and 2 IGPs. The region's grape varieties are Montepulciano, Aglianico and Trebbiano. The location between the Apennines and Adriatic Sea creates multiple climate types. Maritime along the narrow coastal section, temperate in the upper valleys and continental further inland around the mountainous areas, all of which provide different favourable climatic conditions.

Local food specialties not to be missed include: maccheroni alla chitarra (egg pasta), cavatelli pasta, cipolla di Isernia (a large, sweet onion perfect for frittatas), local truffles and Ventricina di Montenero di Bisaccia (a renowned sausage from Campobasso). Both cavatelli and fusilli originated here.

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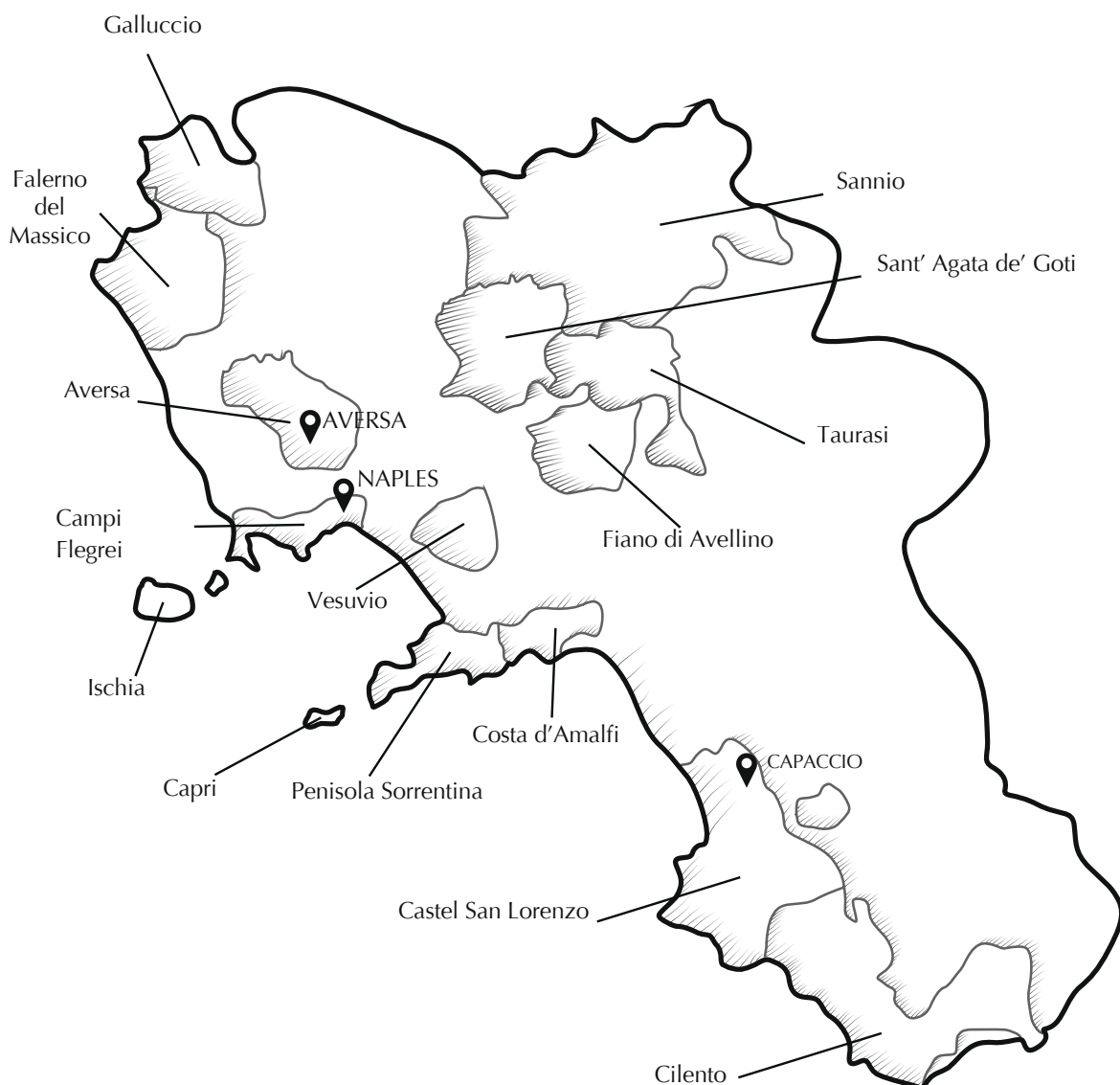
# Campania

## ITALY

Campania is located in the southern part of the Italian peninsula, facing the Tyrrhenian Sea, in what might be called the shin of the peninsula's boot. Its capital and largest city is Naples (Napoli). Tourists know Campania for the city of Naples, the ruins of Pompeii, the isle of Capri, and the beautiful Amalfi Coast.

In the wine world, Campania is best known for red wines made from Aglianico such as Taurasi, and for white wines made from Falanghina, Fiano, and Greco. It has 4 DOCGs, 15 DOCs and 10 IGPs. The region's grape varieties are Aglianico, Greco, Fiano and Falanghina. Vines in Campania benefit not only from coastal breezes but also the coolness that altitude brings.

Pizza Napoletana is a Traditional Speciality Guaranteed (TSG) product, regulated under European law. The 'Art of Neapolitan "Pizzaiuolo"' is also included on UNESCO's list of intangible cultural heritage.

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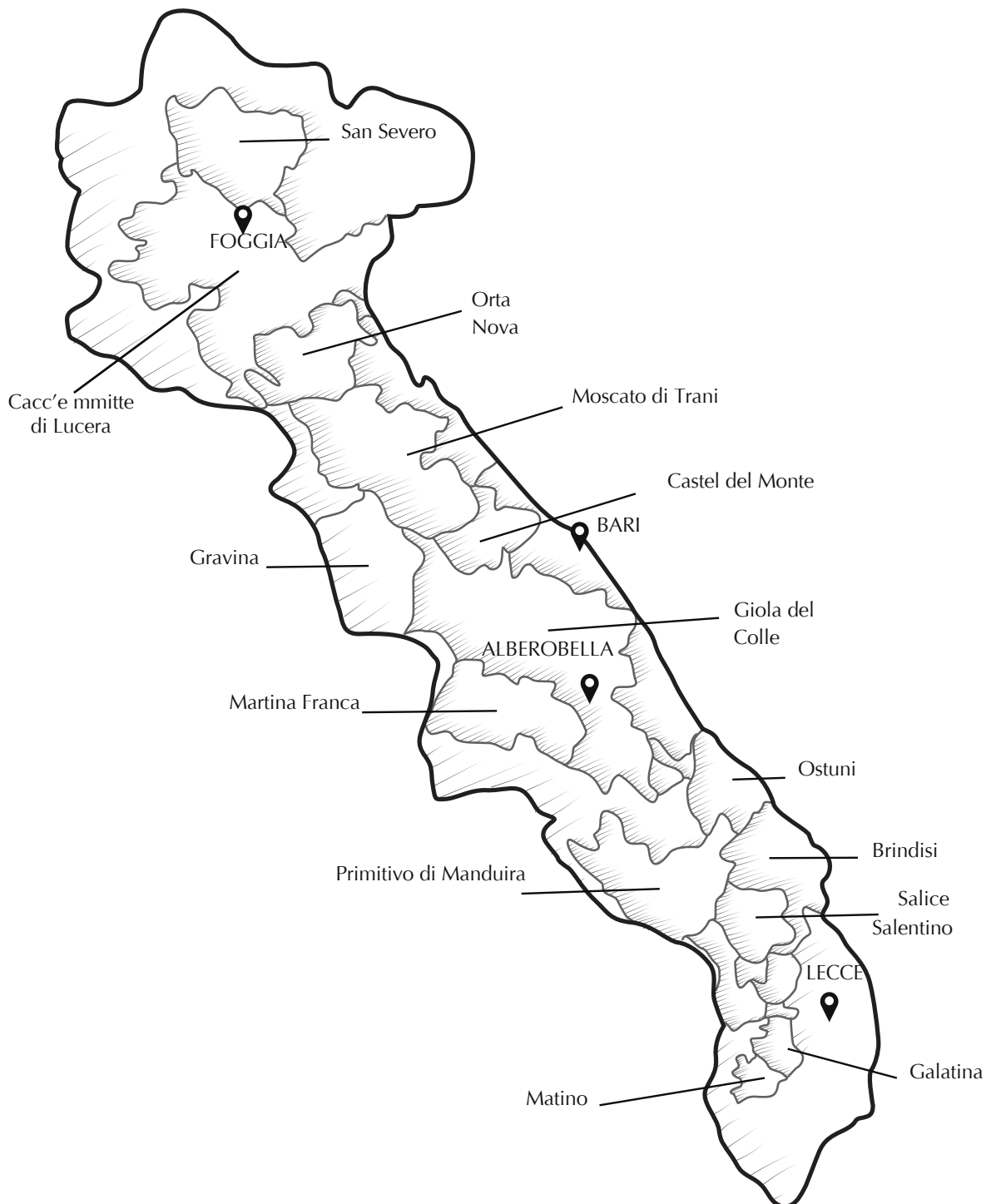

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# Puglia

## ITALY

Puglia (Apulia) forms the heel of the Italian peninsula's boot, running up the Adriatic coast to the boot's "spur." Its capital and largest city is Bari. As one of the least mountainous of Italy's regions, located in the sun-baked south, Puglia is a major agricultural area, for grapes and wine as for other products. In the wine world, Puglia is still not particularly well known, but as quality continually improves, its wines are attracting great interest. It has 4 DOCGs, 28 DOCs, and 6 IGPs.

The region's grape varieties are Sangiovese, Primitivo, Negroamaro, and Trebbiano. Aglianico in Puglia it's grown on calcareous tufo soils that give considerable finesse. Puglia has a mediterranean climate with hot dry summers and mild winters.

# Basilicata

## ITALY

Basilicata forms the arch of the Italian peninsula's boot, running northwest from the Gulf of Taranto. Its capital and largest city is Potenza. In the wine world, Basilicata is not well known, producing less than 0.2% of the country's total output. One of the most mountainous regions in Italy, with around 47% mountains and a further 45% hills. Only 8% of the surface area is classified as being flat.

The mountainous terrain and harsh weather makes vine-growing a challenge. But the area still enjoys an abundance of sunshine throughout the growing season and cool temperatures around harvest, thanks to climatic variations. Primitivo, Sangiovese and Montepulciano also do particularly well, as does Bombino Nero.

The Aglianico grape is the star of the Aglianico del Vulture wine. It has one DOCG, Aglianico del Vulture Superiore DOCG, 4 DOCs. Most traditional dishes are focused around lamb and mutton, including spezzatino di agnello, where lamb is stewed in an earthenware pot with potatoes, onions, bay leaves and peppers. There's also lucanica – a delicious pork sausage that is common all over the region.

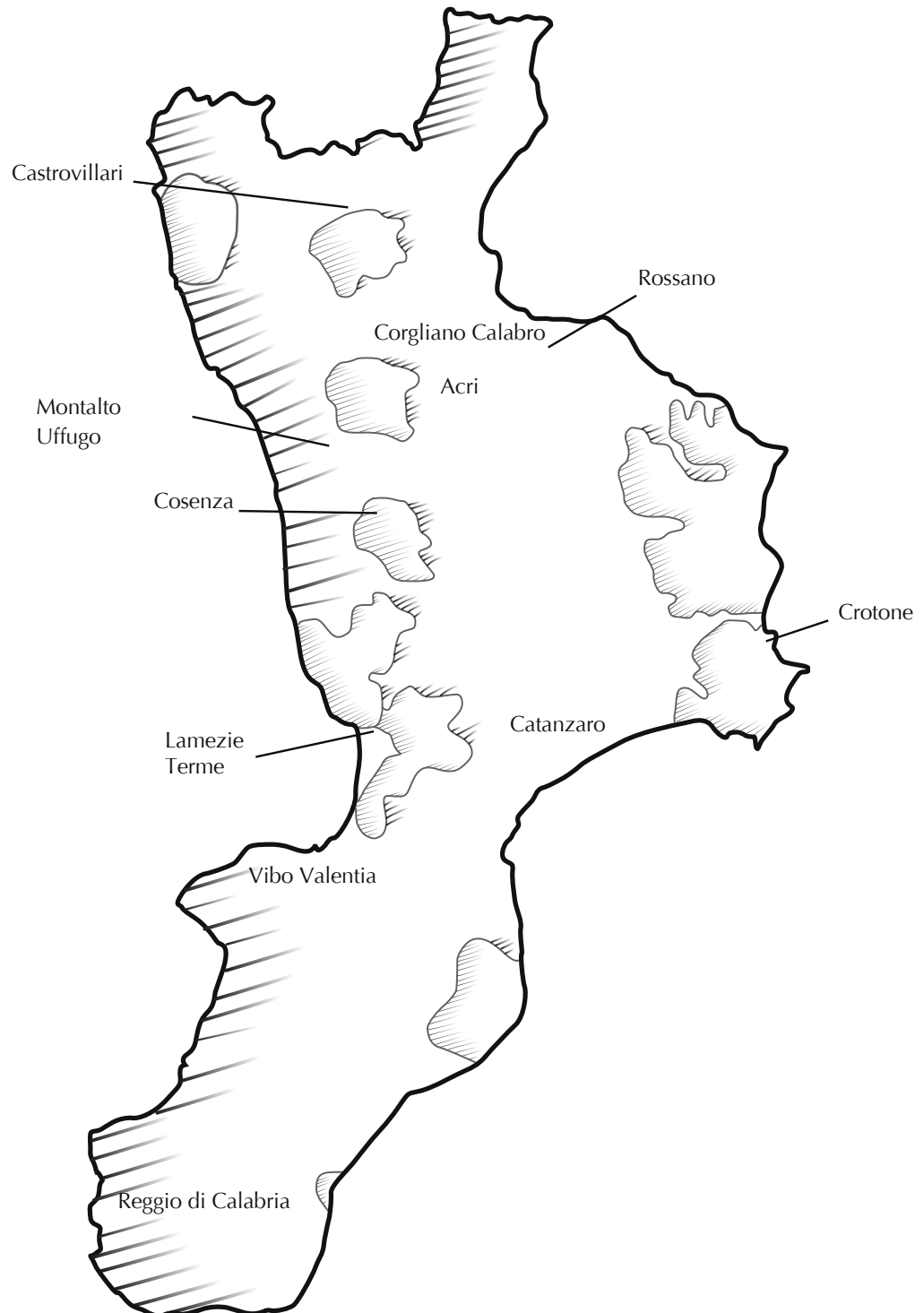
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# Calabria

## ITALY

Calabria forms the toe of the Italian peninsula's boot, from the Strait of Messina northeast to the Gulf of Taranto. Its capital is Catanzaro and its largest city is Reggio di Calabria. In the wine world, Calabria is probably best known for the Cirò denomination. It has no DOCGs, 9 DOCs, and 10 IGP.

Only 0.2% of Italy's total wine production comes from Calabria, yet the spectrum of high quality, diverse wines from distinctive varieties unique to this region is startling and ripe for exploration. More than 90% of Calabrian wine is red, with Gaglioppo making up over half of this.

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# Sardinia

## ITALY

Sardegna (Sardinia) is an island region located west of the Italian peninsula across the Tyrrhenian Sea from Lazio and just south of the French island of Corsica. Tourists know Sardegna best for the trendy beaches of the Costa Smeralda on the northeast tip. In the wine world, Sardegna is best known for red wines made from Cannonau and white wines made from Vermentino. It has 1 DOCG, 17 DOCs, and 15 IGPs.



Known as Grenache in France and Garnacha in Spain, this Mediterranean red grape variety is largely grown in the eastern province of Nuoro and the wild, eastern hillside areas of Barbagia, Ogliastra and Sarrabus, and Romangia in Sardinia's north. First documented in the region in the 19th century, today more than three-quarters of all the Vermentino grown in Italy comes from Sardinia, with production divided between two denominations: the island-wide Vermentino di Sardegna, and the geographically more specific Vermentino di Gallura.

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# Sicily

## ITALY

Sicilia (Sicily) is an island region—the largest island in the Mediterranean—which almost touches the Italian peninsula's toe (Calabria). Its capital and largest city is Palermo. Tourists know Sicilia for the beaches and Greek ruins of the south and east coasts, and its cuisine is world famous.

In the wine world, Sicilia was once best known for the dessert wine Marsala, although today it is more prominent for the dry wines of Etna. It has 1 DOCG, 23 DOCs, and 7 IGPs. In the past, old varieties were abandoned to give space to more productive clones vinified to get more extractive and alcoholic wines suitable for blending.

Its diverse climate and geology are adding even more excitement to the wines being made today. In addition to having the largest area under vine in all of Italy, Sicilia also lays claim to the largest organic vineyard area. Sicilia is home to world-famous foods like the cannoli, artichokes, and all things citrus.

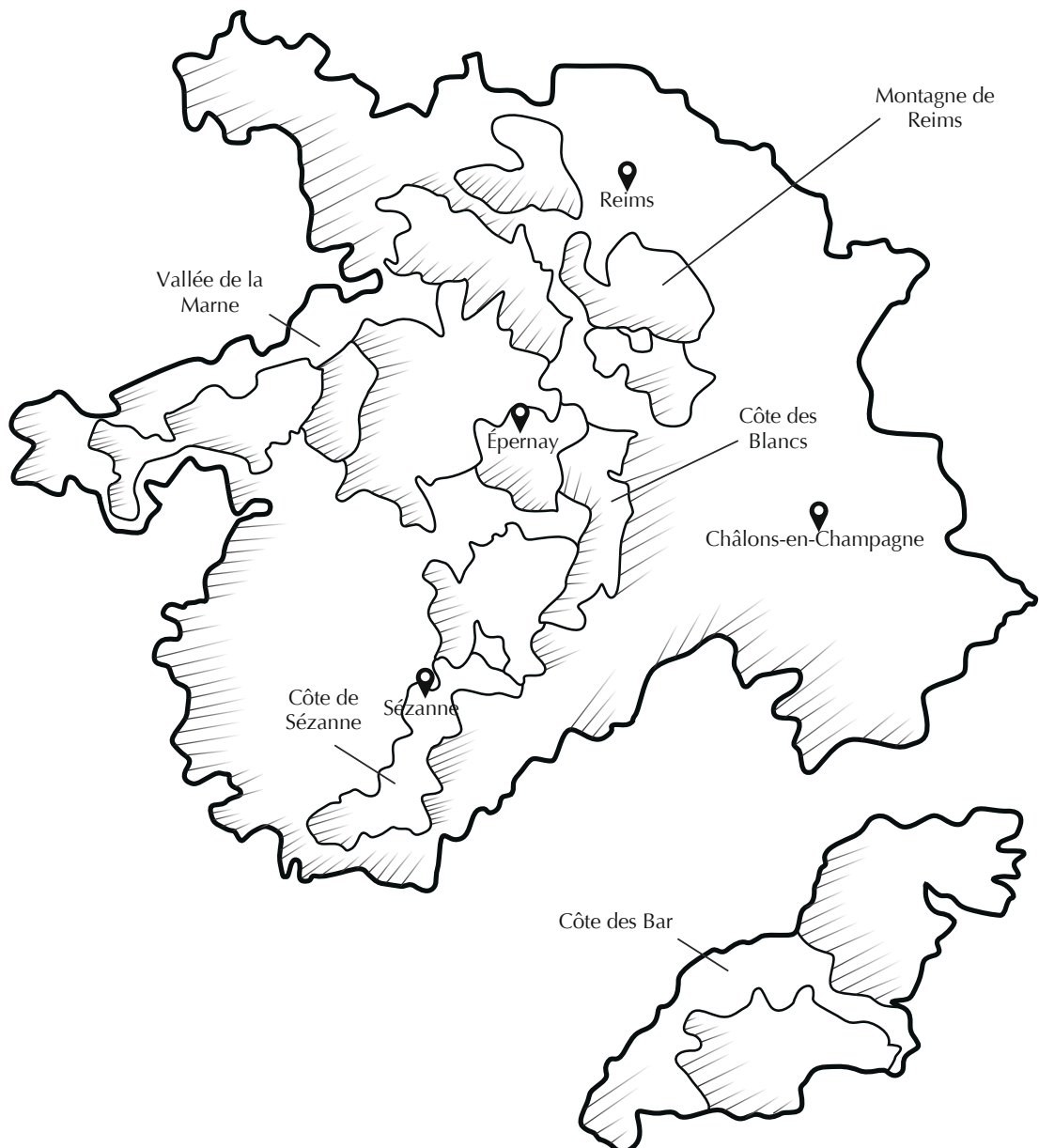
# Champagne
